DCF Car Safety Tips:

Getting In: Check Behind the Car

Before getting in the car and starting the engine, walk around the car and check for kids, toys, and pets! Make sure there is nothing under or behind your car that could attract a young child. Pick up toys, bikes, chalk, or any type of equipment around the driveway so that these items do not entice kids to play.

Getting Out: Check the Back Seat

In just 10 minutes, a car’s temperature can increase by 19°. Before getting out of your car, check the back seat ... Do not forget your child! Never leave your child alone in a car and call 911 if you see any child locked in a car! Place something in the back seat that you will need at work, school, or home (your laptop; your lunch).

Rooms 1–4 Parent-Teacher Conferences – We will be scheduling Parent Teacher conferences for you to discuss your child’s progress. Each teacher will be available for 15-minute individual/family conferences via phone or video chat on Tuesday, October 5th, Wednesday, October 6th, or Thursday, October 7th. More information and appointment scheduling will be available later in the month.

Picture Day – Picture Day for Rooms 1-4 is on Wednesday, October 13th and for Rooms 5-10 is on Thursday, October 14th. Richard’s Photography will be taking individual outdoor portraits (weather permitting). We will start around 9:00 a.m. with the younger children and move on to the older classrooms. Richard suggests that you dress your child in solid color clothing for the best results with the outdoor photos. For attending siblings, if you would like them photographed together, please let the office know and we will have both children photographed on the scheduled day for the younger attending sibling.

All children will be photographed unless you request in writing that your child’s picture not be taken. You will be able to select the portraits and packages of your choice via a secure web site once the proofs are available. Watch for the flyer that will be sent home with further details.
