**Tuition Reminder** – Tuition is due by the first of each month and considered late after the 6<sup>th</sup> of the month. Remember our new tuition rates as of September 1<sup>st</sup>:

### **DCF Car Safety Tips:**

#### Getting In: Check Behind the Car

Before getting in the car and starting the engine, walk around the car and check for kids, toys, and pets! Make sure there is nothing under or behind your car that could attract a young child. Pick up toys, bikes, chalk, or any type of equipment around the driveway so that these items do not entice kids to play.

#### Getting Out: Check the Back Seat

In just 10 minutes, a car's temperature can increase by 19°. Before getting out of your car, check the back seat ... Do not forget your child! Never leave your child alone in a car and call 911 if you see any child locked in a car! Place something in the back seat that you will need at work, school, or home (your laptop; your lunch).

**Rooms 1–4 Parent-Teacher Conferences** – We will be scheduling Parent Teacher conferences for you to discuss your child's progress. Each teacher will be available for 15-minute individual/family conferences via phone or video chat on Tuesday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, or Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. More information and appointment scheduling will be available later in the month.

**Flu and COVID-19 Vaccinations** – Vaccines are the best way to protect against the flu and COVID-19. Because the flu virus changes year to year, annual vaccination against the flu is recommended. The CDC recommends that all children from the ages of 6 months up to their 19th birthday receive a flu vaccine every fall or winter (children receiving a vaccine for the first time require two doses). The CDC recommends COVID-19 primary series vaccines for everyone ages 6 months and older, and COVID-19 boosters for everyone eligible ages 5 years and older. You also can protect your child by receiving a flu and COVID vaccine yourself.
