Water Bottles – As a reminder, water bottles <u>need to arrive clearly labeled with your child's first and last name along with the current date</u>. At our most recent DCF Licensing Inspection, our inspector observed water bottles without names and dates.

**Rooms 1–5 Parent-Teacher Conferences** – We are currently scheduling Parent Teacher conferences for you to discuss your child's progress. Each teacher will be available for 15-minute individual/family conferences in person, via phone or via Zoom on Tuesday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, or Thursday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. **Picture Day** – Picture Day for Rooms 1-5 is Tuesday, October 7<sup>th</sup> and for Rooms 6-10 is Wednesday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. Richard's Photography will be taking individual outdoor portraits (weather permitting). We will start around 9:00 a.m. with the younger children and move on to the older classrooms. Richard suggests that you dress your child in solid color clothing for the best results with the outdoor photos. For attending siblings, if you would like them to be photographed together, please let the office know and we will have both children photographed together and individually on the scheduled day for the younger attending sibling.

All children will be photographed unless you request in writing that your child's picture not be taken. You will be able to select the portraits and packages of your choice via a secure web site once the proofs are available. Flyers with details will be filed in your child's folder in the front office soon.

**Pumpkin Patch** – With the Fall Season and the approach of Halloween festivities, our Annsworth Staff will create a "Pumpkin Patch" outside in our green space for the children to enjoy. This area will be visited by all our classrooms individually and will be used for story circles and for a variety of math and science activities. The "Pumpkin Patch" will be enjoyed by the children Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup> through Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, with each child selecting a pumpkin to take home with them on Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup>.

We are asking each child to bring two pumpkins to school between Monday, Oct. 13<sup>th</sup> and Friday, Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> so that we may begin to prepare the area for these activities. All sizes and colors of pumpkins are welcome (including miniature) as we would like to have a good variety. When bringing your child's pumpkins to school, please place them in the baskets which will be available in the lobby. We will then transport the pumpkins to our "Patch".

Halloween at Annsworth – Halloween is just around the corner! On Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup> we will have our Halloween snack parties. Each classroom will post a sign-up for Halloween item donations for the children to enjoy during their morning snack. The children should wear orange and black to school, but please, no costumes.
