Pre-K Families – Monday, March 16th – Friday, March 20th are Non-VPK days. These days are not counted into the 180 days funded by the state. If your child is absent any of these days, their absence will not count against their VPK funding. As a reminder for VPK only children, these days are not part of their program.

Class Pictures – Class pictures will be taken on Wednesday, March 25th. **We ask that ALL children be here for the picture and that your child is here by 8:30 AM** so that he/she can be included in the class picture. To purchase a copy of your child's class picture, you must order in advance – the order form will be filed in your child's file folder closer to that date. Pre-K classes also have the option to purchase a copy of all the Pre-K children pictured together.

Bike Days – Our Pre-K classes have scheduled a BIKE DAY this month for our Transportation unit. We will flag off the entrance/exit of the circular drive and the children will be allowed to ride their vehicles around the circle during their morning playground time. Please bring a TRIKE or BIKE your child feels safe and comfortable riding. DO NOT send a brand-new bike that your child is not familiar with. We require safety gear, so please provide a BIKE HELMET that fits your child. Please be sure the bike is in good working order and all bolts are tightened and secure. Label both the bike and helmet with your child's name. For helmets and bikes that have action figures on them, please cover the figures with tape. Also, remember to pick up your child's bike at the end of the day. Room 8's Bike Day is March 24th, Room 9's Bike Day is Thursday, March 26th and Room 10's Bike Day is Friday, March 27th.
