Tuition Reminder – Tuition is due by the first of each month and considered late after the 6th of the month. Remember our new tuition rates as of September 1st:

Full Time – \$1,385.00

Three Quarter Day – \$1,235.00

Half Day – \$1100.00

VPK Full Time Wrap Around – \$1035.80*

VPK Three Quarter Day Wrap Around – \$885.80*

VPK Half Day Wrap Around – \$750.80*

School Closed – On Monday, September 7, Annsworth will be closed for the Labor Day Holiday. Morning Arrival – Annsworth is proud to offer a curriculum and quality early education program. A good night's sleep, a wholesome breakfast, morning routines, and prompt arrival will help children function at a higher level and gain so much more from our program. Teachers are so appreciative when families understand the importance of arriving before class starts at 8:30. This will also limit interruptions to the entire group by late arrivals.

Monthly Goals – As the teachers evaluate each child's progress and plan the developmentally appropriate curriculum each month, they set goals and assess all the children's progress in four or five areas of learning. The goals are written on the Lead Teacher's Lesson Plans and posted on the Parent Information Board in each classroom. At the end of each month, these completed "Monthly Goal" forms are copied for the parents, added to the child's portfolio, and used to improve curriculum, adapt teaching practices, and enhance the environment. Our families are encouraged to work with their child to practice the goals and to share with the teachers their own observations about the results of the assessments.
